NEW USER REGISTRATION GUIDE

New Central Sector Scheme for Industrial Development of
Jammu & Kashmir

1. General information

The Scheme has been notified on 19.2.2021 by the Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade (DPIIT) to bring about radical transformation in the existing industrial ecosystem of J&K, thereby enabling Jammu and Kashmir to compete nationally with other leading industrially developed States/ UTs of the country. The Scheme aims to give fresh thrust to industry and services led development of J&K with emphasis on job creation, skill development and sustainable development by attracting new investment and nurturing the existing one. The scheme is for the duration of 2021-22 to 2036-37 with total financial out lay of Rs. 28,400 crore and envisages four types of incentives namely:

- (I) Capital Investment Incentive
- (II) Capital Interest Subvention
- (III) GST Linked Incentive
- (IV) Working Capital Interest Subvention

2. Application stages (How to apply?)

To apply for the New Central Sector Scheme for Industrial Development of Jammu & Kashmir, user must follow the below stated guidelines.

2.1 Register as new user/Login to portal:
